INTRODUCTION TO THE MODULE

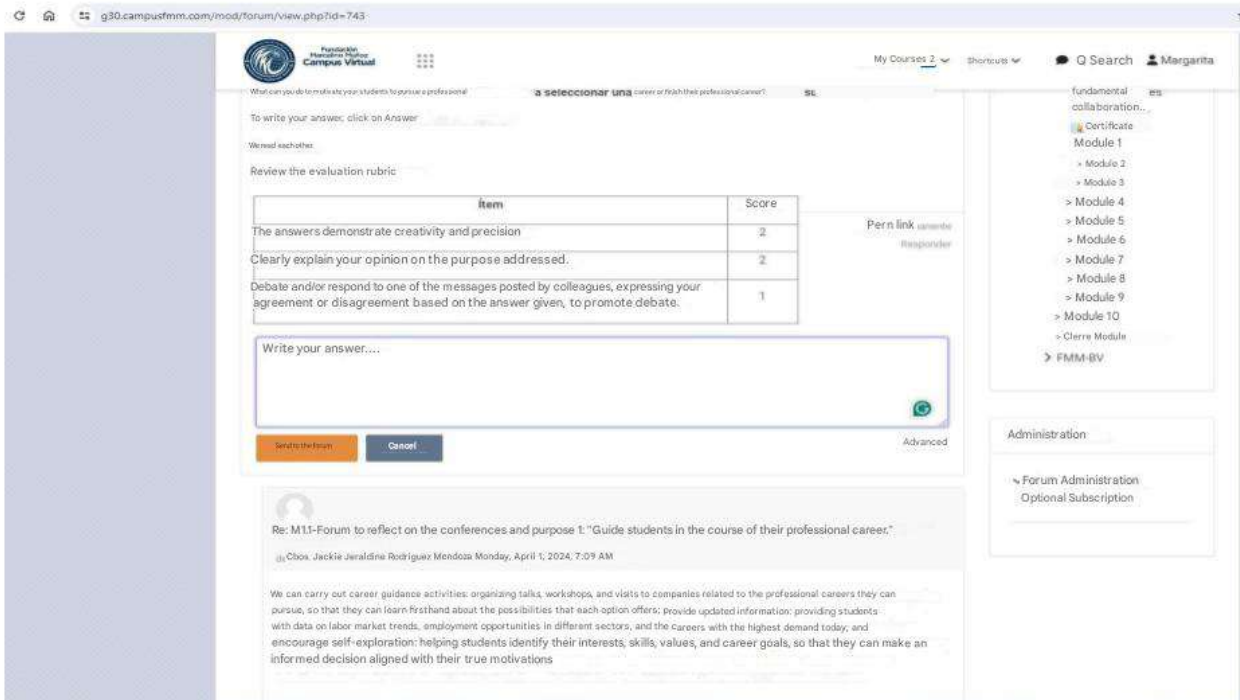

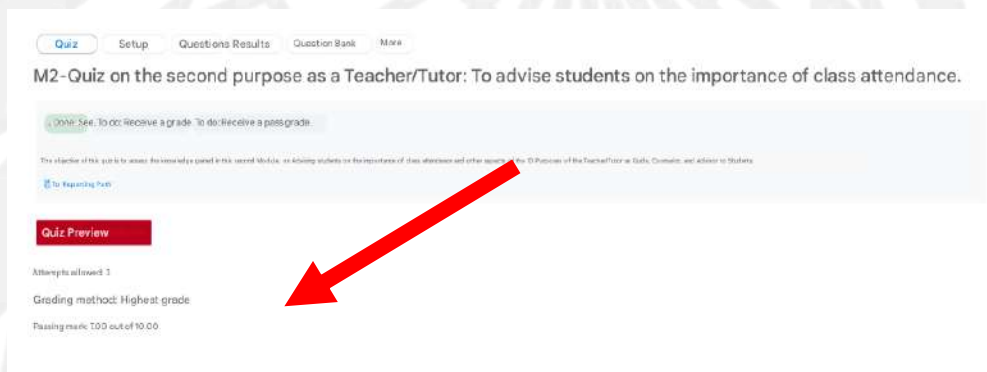

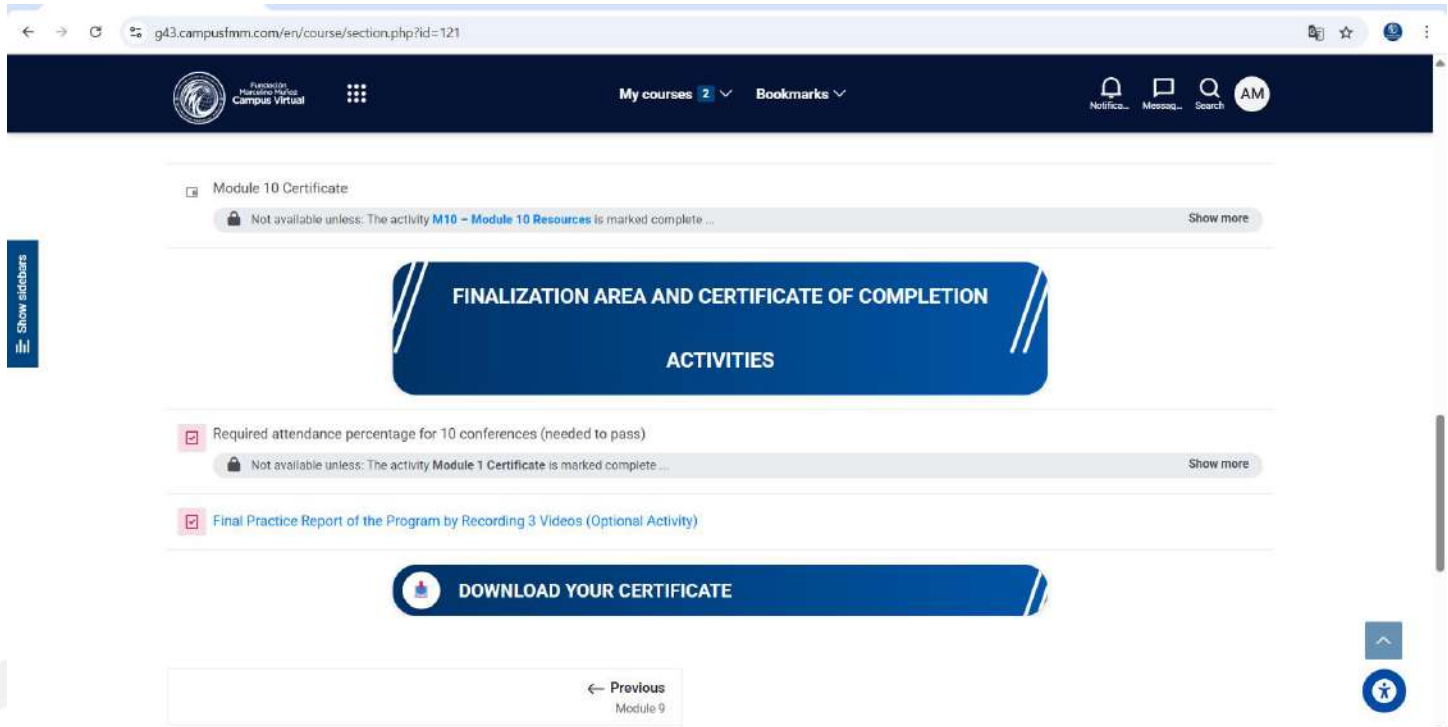
